Tonic water's history begins in 17th-century Peru, where Spanish colonists discovered malaria treatment in quinaquina bark. Some say the Countess of Chinchon brought it to Spain around 1640, others credit Jesuit missionary Barnabe de Cobo in 1632. Known as "Countess's powder" or "Jesuit's powder," the bark became popular in Europe.

In the 18th century, Linnaeus named the tree "cinchona" after the Countess. Its bitter bark was mixed with sugar and carbonated water to improve the taste, and tonic water was first sold in 1858. Around the same time, gin gained respectability, creating the iconic gin and tonic.

#### East Imperial Burma Tonic

Warm and spicy with a hint of cinnamon, top notes of lemongrass and lime.

#### East Imperial Yuzu Tonic

Robust and aromatic sweet citrus flavour, strong Japanese citrus fruit.

#### East Imperial Grapefruit Tonic


